## **ROAD TOUR 2024**

Meet at McDonalds at 10:15

Sign the Registration Form

Set your odometer to zero

Leave McDonalds at 10:30

Exit thru the north exit, turn right, one block to Highway 83 at stop light

Turn left, north, onto Highway 83

At 6.8 miles, turn right, east, onto Beaver Lake Road

At 7.4 miles, turn left, north, onto Fox Run Road

At 7.8 miles, at the stop sign, turn left, north, onto Deer Trail

At the next stop sign, continue straight

At 8.1 mile, at the stop sign, continue straight, north onto Highway E

At 12.0 miles, continue north on Highway K

At 15.0 miles, turn right, east, onto Donegal Road

At 16.5 miles turn left, north, onto Emerald Road

At 17.2 miles, turn right, south, onto St, Augustine Road

At 17.6 miles, at the stop sign, continue straight onto Hogsback Road

At 18.3 miles, turn left, north, onto Friess Lake Road

At 19.7 miles, turn right, east, onto Highway 167

At 21.2 miles, turn left, north, at the roundabout, onto Highway 164

At 22.3 miles, turn right, east, onto Pleasant Hill Road, and then left into the Pleasant Hill Bar and Grill parking lot

*Set your Google Maps for the Wisconsin Automobile Museum in the event you get separated from the group at one of the stop lights in Hartford*

Leave the parking lot thru the north exit and turn left onto Highway 164

Turn right, west, onto Pleasant Hill Road

At 26.4 miles, turn right, north, onto Highway E

At 30.9 miles, turn left, west, onto Highway 60

At 32.6 miles, (one block west of The Mine Shaft) turn right, north, onto Rural Street

The Museum is one block down on the left
